2. The teacher eyed the students suspiciously as they whispered to each other.
3. He eyed the painting critically, trying to assess its true value.
4. As she entered the room, all eyes were on her, and she felt every gaze that eyed her curiously.
5. The cat eyed the bird perched on the windowsill with keen interest.
