Meaning: Fabricate: to create or construct something, often by assembling parts or by inventing a story or idea.

1. The engineer had to fabricate a new part for the machine after realizing the original was defective.
2. She had a talent for fabricating elaborate stories that kept her friends entertained for hours.
3. In order to complete the project on time, they decided to fabricate a prototype from readily available materials.
4. The artist chose to fabricate her sculptures from recycled metal to promote environmental awareness.
5. During the investigation, it became clear that some of the evidence had been fabricated to mislead the authorities.
