

# FACTITIVE

*Meaning: Factitive: relating to a verb or construction that indicates causing someone or something to attain a specific state or condition.*

1. A factitive verb can express the idea of causing someone or something to be in a particular state.
2. In linguistics, a factitive construction often involves a subject and an object that denote a change of state.
3. The teacher made the students happy, demonstrating a clear example of a factitive relationship.
4. Understanding factitive verbs can enhance one's grasp of complex sentence structures.
5. The term 'factitive' is often used in discussions about causative verbs in different languages.
