

FADER

Meaning: FADER: A control mechanism, typically a sliding lever, used to adjust the level of audio signals in sound mixing and production.

1. The sound engineer adjusted the fader to balance the audio levels during the live performance.
2. She gently slid the fader up to increase the volume of the vocals in the mix.
3. In the DJ booth, he expertly manipulated the fader to create a seamless transition between tracks.
4. The old mixing console had a sticky fader that made it difficult to achieve precise control over the sound.
5. Using the fader, he was able to highlight the subtle nuances of each instrument in the recording.
