Meaning: Fallacious: based on a mistaken belief or unsound reasoning; misleading or deceptive in logic.

1. The politician's argument was fallacious, relying on emotional appeals rather than factual evidence.
2. Many people fall victim to fallacious reasoning when they fail to question widely held beliefs.
3. The scientist pointed out the fallacious assumption that correlation implies causation.
