

# FARCTATE

*Meaning: FARCTATE: characterized by being swollen or filled with substance, particularly in reference to densely packed regions in biological structures or fruits.*

1. The farctate model of the cell membrane explains how certain regions become more densely packed with proteins.
2. In botany, the term farctate is often used to describe fruits that are swollen and filled with pulp.
3. The farctate condition of the plant's tissues made it impervious to many common pests.
4. Scientists observed that the farctate state of the tissues could influence the plant's overall resilience to drought.
5. Understanding the farctate nature of certain seeds can help improve agricultural practices and crop yields.

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
