

FELLABLE

Meaning: FELLABLE: (adjective) capable of being cut down or harvested, particularly referring to trees.

1. The logging company identified several trees on the property that were deemed fellable.
2. Due to its health and size, the oak tree in the backyard was considered fellable by the arborist.
3. After a thorough assessment, the environmental team determined that only a few fellable trees would be removed.
4. The contractor provided a list of fellable timber species that would be suitable for the project.
5. Local regulations required permission before any fellable trees could be cut down in the protected area.
