

FEUAR

Meaning: Feuar: a person who holds a feu, or a lease of land, typically with rights to use and develop it, often playing a significant role in the local community.

1. The feuar of the land held a significant role in the local community.
2. She had inherited the feuar from her grandfather, who was a respected figure in the village.
3. As the feuar, he was responsible for maintaining the property and ensuring its value.
4. The feuar agreement stipulated that the land could not be sold without the consent of the governing body.
5. Residents often consulted the feuar regarding disputes over land boundaries and usage.
