

FEUDATARY

Meaning: Feudatory: a vassal or subordinate who holds land from a lord in exchange for loyalty and military service.

1. The king granted the lands to his feudatory, solidifying their alliance.
2. In medieval times, a feudatory often had to provide military support to their liege lord.
3. The feudatory was responsible for governing the territory while paying tribute to the monarch.
4. A powerful feudatory could challenge the central authority if they amassed enough resources.
5. Historians often analyze the relationships between feudatories and their overlords to understand feudal dynamics.

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
