*Meaning: FIDUCIALLY: In a manner that involves a fiduciary duty, characterized by trust and responsibility to act in the best interests of another party.*

1. The trustee acted fiducially, ensuring that all beneficiaries were treated fairly and justly.
2. In her role as a financial advisor, she managed her client's assets fiducially, prioritizing their interests above her own.
3. The company's fiduciary duty required its management to operate fiducially, maintaining transparency and accountability.
