

# FIEF

*Meaning: A fief is a parcel of land or estate granted by a lord to a vassal in exchange for loyalty and service, typically including rights to the resources and the labor of those living on it.*

1. The nobleman was granted a fief in exchange for his loyalty to the king.
2. In the medieval era, a fief often included land, villages, and the serfs who worked it.
3. She inherited her father's fief and took on the responsibilities of managing it.
4. The concept of a fief was central to the feudal system that dominated Europe.
5. With the decline of feudalism, many fiefs were consolidated into larger estates.
