Meaning: Fining refers to the act of imposing a monetary penalty on an individual or organization as a punishment for an offense or violation.

1. The judge imposed a heavy fining on the company for its environmental violations.
2. She was surprised to learn that fining offenders could sometimes lead to community service instead of jail time.
3. The city council debated the effectiveness of fining litterers versus implementing a public awareness campaign.
4. Fining individuals for repeated parking violations is a common practice in many urban areas.
