Meaning: FIRMLESS: lacking firmness, solidity, or decisiveness; soft or weak in texture or conviction.

3. Her arguments were convincing, yet they seemed firmless without solid evidence to support them.
4. The old mattress had become firmless over time, offering little support for a good night's sleep.
