

FISTULA

Meaning: Fistula: an abnormal passage or connection between two internal organs or vessels, often resulting from disease or surgical intervention.

1. A fistula is an abnormal connection between two body parts, often caused by disease or injury.
2. The surgeon explained the risks associated with the creation of a fistula for dialysis access.
3. Patients with inflammatory bowel disease may develop a fistula as a complication of their condition.
