

FLAIL

Meaning: To flail means to wave or swing one's arms or legs wildly or uncontrollably, often in a frantic or excited manner.

1. The child began to flail her arms in excitement when she saw the puppy.
2. In the water, he started to flail desperately as he struggled to stay afloat.
3. During the argument, she would often flail her hands, emphasizing her frustration.
4. The actor attempted to portray a sense of panic, flailing about in a dramatic fashion.
5. As the storm intensified, the trees began to flail wildly in the wind.
