

FLENSE

Meaning: To flense is to strip the blubber or skin from a whale or fish, typically for processing.

1. Whalers would often flense the blubber from the whale immediately after it was caught.
2. In the traditional method, workers would flense the fish on the deck to maximize freshness.
3. The crew expertly flensed the carcass, separating the meat from the bones with precision.
4. After the hunt, they gathered to flense the seals they had hunted for their skins and oil.
5. To ensure no part of the whale went to waste, they meticulously flensed every section of fat and flesh.
