Meaning: Flicker: to shine unsteadily or intermittently, often due to a disturbance or a momentary change in intensity.

1. The candlelight began to flicker as a slight breeze entered the room.
2. Her hope flickered for a moment before being extinguished by reality.
3. The television screen would flicker occasionally, disrupting the show.
4. In the twilight, fireflies danced and flickered like tiny stars in the dark.
5. He watched the flicker of the flames, lost in thought by the campfire.
6. The candle's flame began to flicker in the drafty room.
7. As the thunderstorm rolled in, the lights flickered ominously.
8. Her eyes seemed to flicker with excitement when she saw the surprise party.
