Meaning: Flocculus: a small, fluffy mass or clump of particles, such as algae or sediment, that forms and floats in a liquid.

1. The scientist observed a flocculus of algae floating on the surface of the pond.
2. In the laboratory, the researcher noted the formation of a flocculus during the chemical reaction.
3. A small flocculus of cotton candy adorned the top of the child's ice cream cone.
4. The flocculus of clouds drifted lazily across the bright blue sky.
