

# FORAMEN

*Meaning: Foramen: a small opening or passage in a bone or structure, typically allowing the passage of nerves and blood vessels.*

1. The foramina in the human skull serve as passageways for nerves and blood vessels.
2. During the dissection, the students identified the foramina that allowed for the exit of cranial nerves.
3. In anatomy, foramina are crucial for understanding how structures communicate within the body.
4. The foraminal openings in the vertebrae play a significant role in protecting the spinal cord.
