2. Her sudden silence was a foreboder of the tension that lay just beneath the surface of the conversation.
3. The eerie silence in the woods served as a foreboder of the danger that lurked nearby.
4. In literature, the appearance of a raven often acts as a foreboder of impending doom.
5. His uneasy expression was a foreboder of the trouble that was soon to unfold.
