

FORFALTURE

Meaning: Forfalture refers to the forfeiture or loss of rights, privileges, or property due to failure to fulfill an obligation or requirement.

1. The player faced a forfalture when he failed to appear for the match.
2. Due to the forfalture of the contract, the company was left with no choice but to seek new partners.
3. In the event of a forfalture, the team would forfeit their chance at the championship title.
4. The forfalture clause in the agreement clearly stated the penalties for noncompliance.
5. Her absence from the final exam led to a forfalture, impacting her overall grade.
