

FORFEITURE

Meaning: Forfeiture is the loss of rights, property, or privileges as a penalty for wrongdoing or failure to fulfill an obligation.

1. The athlete faced a potential forfeiture of his championship title due to a doping violation.
2. In the event of non-payment, the lease agreement included a clause about the forfeiture of the security deposit.
3. The government implemented strict measures to prevent the forfeiture of public lands to private developers.
4. After failing to meet the contractual obligations, the company was subjected to the forfeiture of its licenses.
5. The judge ruled that the forfeiture of the defendant's assets was warranted due to their involvement in illegal activities.
