Meaning: Formalist: a person or approach that prioritizes the structure, form, and aesthetic elements of a work over its content, meaning, or context.

1. The formalist approach to literature emphasizes the structure and form of a text over its content.
2. In art criticism, a formalist perspective focuses on the visual elements rather than the emotional or contextual implications.
3. Many formalist theorists argue that understanding the rules of composition is essential for appreciating a work of art.
4. The formalist school of thought in architecture advocates for designs that prioritize geometric shapes and materials.
