

FORZANDO

Meaning: Forzando is a musical term indicating a sudden, strong emphasis or accent on a note or chord.

1. The musician played the passage with a forzando, emphasizing the climactic moment of the piece.
2. In the score, the forzando marking instructed the orchestra to strike the chords with sudden intensity.
3. As she reached the dramatic climax of the song, her voice soared with a powerful forzando that captivated the audience.
