

FRAGMENTARILY

Meaning: Fragmentarily: in a manner that presents something in incomplete or disjointed parts.

1. The story was told fragmentarily, leaving the audience confused about the timeline.
2. Her memories of the trip were fragmentarily pieced together, like a jigsaw puzzle missing key pieces.
3. The lecture was delivered fragmentarily, jumping from one topic to another without clear transitions.
4. He recalled his childhood fragmentarily, with only flashes of laughter and fleeting moments of joy.
5. The documentary presented the events fragmentarily, requiring viewers to connect the dots themselves.
