Meaning: Fraying refers to the process of becoming worn, tattered, or unraveled at the edges, or to the gradual deterioration of something, such as patience or composure.

1. The edges of the fabric were fraying after years of use.
2. Her patience was fraying as the deadline approached.
3. The constant friction was fraying the relationship between the two friends.
4. The fraying rope signaled that it was time to replace the old equipment.
5. He could see the fraying threads of her sweater, a sign of its age.
