Meaning: Fuliginously: in a manner that is dark, murky, or resembling soot; often used to describe colors or appearances that are shadowy or obscured.

1. The river flowed fuliginously, its dark waters swirling with unseen depths.
2. As the storm clouds gathered, the sky turned a fuliginous shade, hinting at the impending downpour.
3. Her thoughts were fuliginously tangled, shrouded in confusion and doubt.
