

# FUSTIGATION

*Meaning: Fustigation refers to severe criticism or reprimand, often delivered in a harsh or public manner.*

1. The teacher's fustigation of the student's careless errors was both harsh and public.
2. After the scandal broke, the politician faced severe fustigation from the media and the public alike.
3. A fustigation of the outdated policies was necessary to bring about meaningful reform.
4. His fustigation of the project's shortcomings was intended to motivate the team to improve.
5. In literature, fustigation often serves as a tool for social critique and reflection.
