

# FUTTOCK

*Meaning: Futtock: a curved timber or piece of wood used in shipbuilding to connect the ribs of a hull and support the mast.*

1. The shipwright carefully examined the futtock to ensure it was sturdy enough for the new mast.
2. In traditional shipbuilding, the futtock serves as an essential component connecting the ribs of the hull.
3. As the crew prepared the vessel for launch, they checked each futtock for signs of wear and tear.

5. During the restoration, they replaced the old futtocks with new, stronger timbers for better durability.
