

GABIONED

Meaning: Gabioned refers to structures made of wire mesh or similar materials filled with rocks or other materials, used for stabilization and erosion control in construction and landscape design.

1. The riverbanks were reinforced with gabioned structures to prevent erosion during heavy rains.
2. In the landscape design, gabioned walls added both stability and an aesthetic element to the garden.
3. The construction team opted for gabioned barriers to enhance the durability of the highway's edges.
4. During the project, they discovered that gabioned fences provided excellent sound insulation in urban areas.
5. The artist incorporated gabioned forms into her sculpture, blending nature with modern engineering.
