Meaning: Gambison: a padded garment worn under armor for added protection in combat.

1. The knight donned his gambison under the chainmail for added protection.
2. In the reenactment, each participant wore a gambison to prevent injury during combat.
3. Historically, a gambison was often used as a padding beneath armor in medieval warfare.
4. The gambison, made from quilted fabric, provided both comfort and defense to soldiers.
5. During the training session, the coach emphasized the importance of wearing a gambison for safety.
