

GARBLE

Meaning: Garble: to distort or confuse (a message or speech) so that it becomes unclear or difficult to understand.

1. The radio signal began to garble, making it difficult to understand the message.
2. She tended to garble her words when she was nervous, leaving her audience confused.
3. As the child recounted the story, he managed to garble several key details.
4. The software occasionally garbles the text when translating to different languages.
