Meaning: Gaspereau refers to a type of small fish, specifically the alewife or blueback herring, that migrates upstream in rivers during spawning season.

1. The fishermen returned with a large catch of gaspereau from the river.
2. During the spring run, gaspereau are a common sight leaping upstream.
3. The local recipe featured smoked gaspereau, seasoned with herbs and spices.
4. In the quiet evenings, you could hear the gentle splash of gaspereau in the water.
5. Gaspereau are often used as bait by anglers seeking larger fish in the area.
