Meaning: Gastrolith: a stone or pebble ingested by certain animals, particularly dinosaurs, to aid in the grinding and digestion of food.

1. Some dinosaurs are believed to have used gastroliths to help grind their food.
2. The discovery of gastroliths in a fossilized creature provided insights into its dietary habits.
3. Researchers found that the size and shape of the gastroliths can indicate the type of food consumed by ancient animals.
4. Gastroliths can be important for understanding the evolution of digestive processes in reptiles.
5. Paleontologists often analyze gastroliths to make inferences about the environment in which prehistoric species lived.

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
