2. She gauged their reactions carefully to determine if the surprise party was a good idea.
3. After measuring the fabric, he gauged how much more he would need for the project.
4. The teacher gauged the students' understanding through a series of informal assessments.
5. As the storm approached, the meteorologist gauged the potential impact on the coastal areas.
