

GEMINAL

Meaning: Geminal refers to a chemical structure in which two identical functional groups or substituents are attached to the same atom in a molecule.

1. The geminal structure of the compound allowed for unique reactivity in chemical reactions.
2. Researchers focused on the geminal diol to enhance the efficiency of the synthesis process.
3. In organic chemistry, geminal carbons are those that are bonded to two identical functional groups.
4. The geminal arrangement of the substituents provided insight into the molecule's stereochemistry.
5. Identifying geminal relationships in the data set revealed patterns previously overlooked by analysts.
