Meaning: Generalization is the process of applying a conclusion drawn from specific instances to broader situations, which can lead to misconceptions if not backed by evidence.

1. Generalization can often lead to misconceptions if not supported by specific evidence.
2. In psychology, a generalization is made when a behavior observed in one context is applied to other similar situations.
3. The generalization of certain traits across a population can sometimes overlook individual differences.
4. While generalization is useful for understanding trends, it can oversimplify complex realities.
5. Her argument relied on a faulty generalization that did not account for the nuances of the issue.
