

GENUS

Meaning: Genus is a taxonomic rank that groups together species that are closely related and share a common ancestor, positioned above species and below family in the classification hierarchy.

1. The biologist classified the new species under the genus that included several closely related plants.
2. In taxonomy, a genus is ranked above species and below family in the hierarchical classification of organisms.
3. Researchers discovered a previously unknown genus of bacteria in the hot springs of Yellowstone National Park.
4. The genus Pantera includes some of the most well-known big cats, such as lions and tigers.
5. Studying the characteristics of a genus helps scientists understand evolutionary relationships among species.
