

GERMINATE

Meaning: Germinate: to begin to grow or develop, especially from a seed.

1. The seeds will germinate within a week if kept in a warm, moist environment.
2. Farmers eagerly watch for the first signs of their crops as they begin to germinate in the spring.
3. When conditions are right, the dormant seeds in the soil can germinate and sprout into new plants.
4. To encourage the seeds to germinate, it is important to provide adequate sunlight and water.
5. After a few days of soaking in water, the beans started to germinate and sprout tiny roots.

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
