Meaning: GIRE (verb): To manipulate or shape a material, such as fabric or clay, into a desired form or design.

1. She decided to gire the fabric in a way that would create beautiful drapes.

3. The dancer had a unique ability to gire gracefully across the stage, captivating the audience.
4. To achieve the perfect soufflé, you must gire the ingredients gently to incorporate air.
