1. The glairy texture of the egg whites made the meringue light and fluffy.

3. She wiped the glairy substance from her hands, wondering what it could be.
4. The artist used a glairy medium to give the painting a unique, glossy finish.
5. As the fog rolled in, everything outside took on a glairy appearance, blending into the mist.
