Meaning: Globule: a small spherical mass of liquid or substance.

1. The scientist observed a globule of liquid forming at the end of the pipette.
2. Under the microscope, the globules of fat appeared to be moving independently.
3. In the experiment, each globule of dye created a vibrant splash of color in the solution.
4. The globule of mercury rolled across the surface of the table, reflecting light.
5. During the analysis, they noted that the size of the globules could affect the reaction speed.
