Meaning: Gonad: a reproductive organ that produces gametes (sperm or eggs) in male and female organisms.

1. The gonad is responsible for producing gametes in both males and females.
2. In many animal species, the gonad can be found in various shapes and sizes depending on the organism's reproductive strategy.
3. Hormonal changes during puberty significantly affect the development and function of the gonads.
4. Scientists study the role of the gonad in reproductive health to better understand fertility issues.
5. In some fish, the gonad can change sex throughout their lifespan in response to environmental factors.
