

GOOSEWING

Meaning: Goosewing refers to a type of brush with a curved shape used for painting, as well as a distinctive pattern or marking resembling the shape of a goose's wing, often seen in bird feathers.

1. The artist used a goosewing brush to create soft, sweeping strokes in her landscape painting.
