

GROUNDSILL

Meaning: Groundsill: a horizontal structural member at the base of a wall or building that provides support and stability.

1. The carpenter carefully measured the groundsill before securing it in place.
2. To ensure stability, the contractor recommended using treated wood for the groundsill of the house.
3. After inspecting the foundation, the inspector noted that the groundsill was improperly installed.
4. The groundsill serves as the critical first step in constructing a solid frame for the building.
5. During the renovation, they decided to replace the old groundsill that had rotted over time.
