

GUARDANT

Meaning: Guardant (adjective): facing forward or looking outwards, especially in heraldry, as in a figure or animal depicted in a position that shows its face to the viewer.

1. The guardant lion on the family crest symbolizes courage and strength.
2. In ancient heraldry, a guardant figure is often depicted facing the viewer.
3. The artist chose to portray the eagle in a guardant position to convey vigilance.
4. During the ceremony, the guardant statue seemed to watch over the proceedings.
5. The guardant pose of the statue captured the attention of all who passed by.
6. In medieval heraldry, the guardant position often indicated a readiness to defend.
7. The statue of the guardant figure stood proudly at the entrance of the castle.
