Meaning: Guilder: a former gold or silver coin and monetary unit of the Netherlands, historically used as a currency.

1. The painter was paid in guilders for his exquisite work.
2. During the 17th century, the guilder was a dominant currency in the Netherlands.
3. After the economic reforms, the old guilder was replaced by the euro.
4. The collector cherished his antique coins, especially the rare guilder from the 1600s.
5. In discussions about historical trade, the guilder often comes up as a key currency.
