Meaning: A gusset is a triangular or shaped piece of material added to a garment or structure to provide reinforcement, support, or increased flexibility.

1. The tailor added a gusset to the armpit of the shirt to allow for greater movement.
2. In construction, a gusset plate is often used to join structural components together securely.
3. She admired the unique design of the bag, especially the gusset that provided extra space.
4. The parachute's gusset helps to stabilize its descent by increasing surface area.
5. When sewing, incorporating a gusset can enhance the fit of a garment significantly.
