Meaning: GUTTIFORM: resembling or shaped like a drop or tear, often used to describe a design or form that conveys fluidity and movement.

1. The guttiform design of the vase made it a standout piece in the gallery.

3. The marine biologist noted the guttiform structure of the fish as an adaptation to its environment.
