

HAEMIC

Meaning: Haemic refers to anything related to blood or the components of blood, particularly in the context of its physiological functions or conditions.

1. The haemolytic reaction led to a significant drop in the patient's haemoglobin levels.

3. Haemic conditions can often be diagnosed through a simple blood test.
